As a result of our audit performed on February 14, 2008, Brandex Components' facility is considered suitably equipped to assemble military product as specified in MIL-DTL-26482. The corrective actions you have submitted in response to the nonconformances noted during the audit are satisfactory and all findings are closed. Your corrective actions will be reviewed during the next periodic audit at your facility.

The results of the DSCC audit were found by examining a sampling of your company's normal assembly, inspection and processing procedures. The acceptance of the corrective actions submitted in response to the above referenced audit does not relieve Brandex Components of its contractual obligation to deliver product that complies with all specification requirements.

This approval is valid until terminated by written notification from the Qualifying Activity. The normal period of Facility Approval is five years from the date of the audit. If warranted, Facility Approval may be withdrawn by this Center at any time. Your facility may be re-audited at any time. Your Facility Approval is subject to the conditions stated in DoD Manual 4120.24M, SD-6, and DSCC-VQP's booklet entitled "Certification and Qualification Information for Conventional Specifications".
